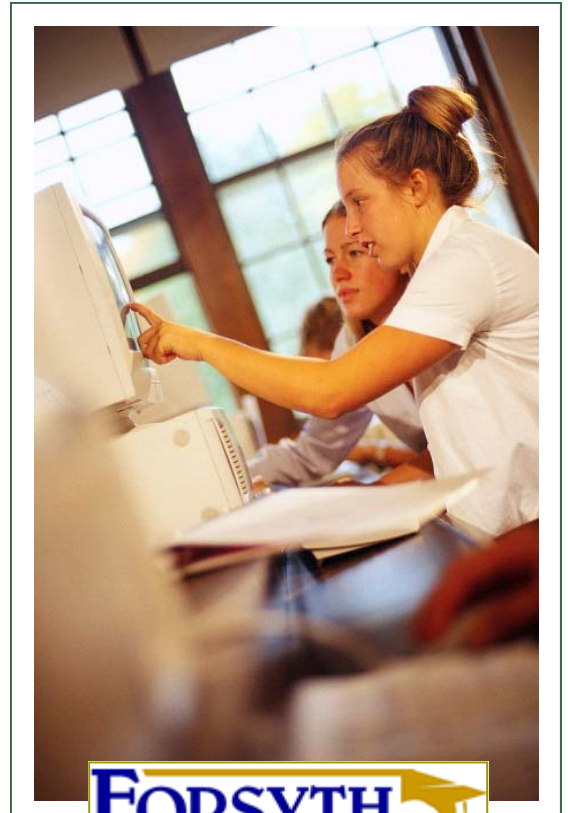

Student Work Habits.



Students will receive feedback on
their report cards using a 1-2-3 scale.

Success



2 = SUCCESS

Assignment Completion:

2 = Student produces completed work on a consistent basis by designated time/date; follows directions.

Participation:

2 = Student engages in activities and class discussions.

Responsibility

2 = Student is a self-starter; remains on task; asks questions for clarifications when needed; applies strategies for meeting learning goals; follows class procedures.

Interpersonal Skills:

2 = Student works well with peers; listens and speaks respectfully; questions ideas rather than the person.
