Advanced Studies Program

The Advanced Studies Program at Lambert High School serves to bring teachers together from each of the academic subject areas (English/Language Arts, Fine Arts, Foreign Language, Math, Science and Social Studies) to provide students with high quality instruction in a wide range of courses. The most prominent component of the Advanced Studies Program is the delivery of college-level coursework through the offering of Advanced Placement courses. The Advanced Studies Program serves nearly a quarter of the student body at Lambert High School across 25 different AP courses, and has produced hundreds of distinguished students ranging from AP Scholars (Scores of 3 or higher on three or more exams) to National AP Scholars (scores of 4 or higher on eight or more exams AND an AP Exam average score over 4) in just two years. The goal of the Advanced Studies Program is ultimately to produce college-ready students that are not only able to think critically, but also able to do the work that it takes to be successful in college and beyond.

Lambert High School sits on 68 acres in Southeast Forsyth County, Georgia. LHS was named after Dr. Clarence Lambert, former Forsyth County School Superintendent, and has developed a family-friendly, highly-challenging academic environment. On July 18th, 2009, Lambert High School officially opened its doors to 1,400 students and 85 staff members in grades 9 through 11; a senior class was added the following year. On June 1, 2011, Lambert's principal, Dr. Gary Davison, proudly shook the hands of 406 students as they crossed the stage at the Inaugural Commencement Ceremony to become Lambert High School's first alumni.
