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#### PRESS RELEASE: NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Forsyth County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 15.91 percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at the Forsyth County Board of Education Central Office Building, 1120 Dahlonega Highway, Cumming, Georgia on Tuesday, June 21, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and at 7:00 p.m.

Additional hearing on this tax increase will be held at the Forsyth County Board of Education Central Office Building, 1120 Dahlonega Highway, Cumming, Georgia on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 17.30 mills, an increase of 2.375 mills above the rollback rate. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 14.925 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$400,000 is approximately \$375.25 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$350,000 is approximately \$332.50
