

CHECKING YOUR HOPE GPA

Your Georgia high school HOPE GPA starts calculating as soon as you begin 9th grade. Unlike your overall GPA, your HOPE GPA only includes your core curriculum courses: English, math, science, social studies, and world language.

Here is how you can check your HOPE GPA on Gafutures.

STEP 1. CREATE AN ACCOUNT ON GAFUTURES

STEP 2. LOG IN AND GO TO YOUR *MY HIGH SCHOOL HOPE GPA* PAGE

Log into your Gafutures account and go to your *My High School HOPE GPA*
