



**2020 Graduations Held at the Infinite Energy Arena (This may be revised!!!)**

- **Tickets:** At our senior meeting/graduation practice on Wednesday, July 29<sup>th</sup>, all graduates will receive ten (10) guest tickets. If a graduate does not need all 10 tickets, or if a graduate needs additional tickets, please contact Ms. Becky Dean no later than June 30<sup>th</sup>. Tickets are required for entry. - **Parking:** At graduation practice, all graduates will also receive parking passes that must be placed on the dashboard of their cars upon entering the Infinite Energy Arena parking lot on graduation day. Teachers involved in the graduation ceremony will also receive parking passes prior to the event.

**For all other guests, a parking fee of \$5 per car is being charged this year by the Arena. To improve traffic flow, it is highly encouraged that guests purchase their parking passes in advance.**

**On graduation day, ONLY debit/credit cards will be accepted. Carpooling is strongly encouraged.**

- **Prohibited items include:**
  - Weapons of any kind
  - No bags, backpacks, briefcases, or purses larger than 14" x 14" x 6".
  - Electronic devices larger than a cell phone (e.g. Laptops, iPads or other tablets)
  - Cameras with detachable lenses
  - Video cameras, including GoPro cameras and audio recording devices
  - External/private video companies/videographers or photographers
  - Selfie-sticks
  - Signs on sticks or oversized signs (no larger than 8 1/2" x 11")
  - No coolers or outside food or beverage
  - Smoking of any kind, including but not limited to tobacco, vapor or e-cigarettes
  - Illegal drugs
  - Laser pointers
  - Mace or pepper spray
  - Spiked or studded jewelry
  - Full facial coverings, like masks
  - Apparel with explicit wording or pictures
  - Crowd surfing
  - Hoverboards
  - Balloons
  - Stickers
  - Umbrellas
  - Strollers
  - Animals, excluding service animals
