



Select Elective Courses

- ✓ Teachers have made Academic/Career Tech and Fine Arts Recommendations in the Portal. Use the online waiver form to request changes to those courses. Waiver form is available through WFHS website/ registration.
- ✓ Online waivers open March 16th 8 am. Waiver deadline is March 23rd at 4 pm.
- ✓ Portal Opens on March 4th at 8 am and closes on March 11th at 4 pm.
- ✓ Some courses/programs need applications (@) or teacher approval (#). Application deadline was advertised and was 2/7/2020.
- ✓ Students requesting to take 2 sciences courses must complete the Double Science Form for approval.
- ✓ “Y” or full year courses are 1 period unless designated. “S” or semester courses are entered as a pair, enter both course numbers.
- ✓ Register for a full 7 period schedule 70/70 including 3 alternative elective or course choices. Rigor courses are **BOLD**.
- ✓ Dropping an AP class at the semester will result in an on-level credit being posted on transcript (schedule permitting).
- ✓ There are no course changes after the waivers close. Make your decisions carefully.
