Checklist for WFHS Dual Enrollment Students

Thank you for viewing the WFHS Dual Enrollment presentation. Please complete the following steps:

- ✓ Meet with counselor to discuss dual enrollment and pick up packet
- ✓ Apply to the college of choice through their Dual Enrollment website
- ✓ Submit SAT or ACT Scores (or PSAT or Accuplacer for Lanier Tech.) Check the college websites for deadlines and necessary testing requirements
- ✓ Submit transcript to college you are applying to via the Parchment website www.parchment.com
- ✓ Parent and student will need to sign all required portions of the Forsyth County Dual Enrollment Student Advisement Plan https://docs.google.com/document/d/19ksydYtXFwdh6ZBuJSvFCImT8xL3_FEYMW66WLnM-g8/edit
- ✓ Once accepted, you will need to return packet to your WFHS counselor and complete the funding application through the GAfutures website. Dual Enrollment classes cannot be scheduled until the following steps have been completed. <https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/scholarships-grants/dual-enrollment/application-procedure-and-deadline/>
- ✓ Set up meeting with college advisor to register for classes. You will need to meet with your college advisor to register for fall classes and then you will need to meet again to register for spring classes. **WFHS counselors are NOT responsible for registering you for DE classes.**
- ✓ Provide a copy of your DE schedule to your WFHS counselor
