

RICHARD B. NEVILLE, JR., MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Richard B. Neville, Jr., Memorial Scholarship is given in memory of Judge Richard Neville. Judge Neville was a practicing attorney in Cumming from 1963 to 1978 before being appointed Superior Court Judge and later Chief Judge of the Blue Ridge Judicial Circuit from 1978 until his death in 1984. The Scholarship has been awarded since 1984.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- (1) Forsyth County resident for at least one (1) year.
- (2) Will be attending an accredited college.
- (3) Graduate of Forsyth County Central High School, North Forsyth High School, West Forsyth High School, South Forsyth High School, or Lambert High School in year making application.
