

DUAL ENROLLMENT ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

LHS and each individual college has specific requirements to participate in Dual Enrollment. Students are responsible for completing the admission and registration process with their LHS Counselor and their college advisor.

Please Note: Only rising 11th and 12th graders can apply for DE at GSU. Rising 10th graders are ineligible for GSU.

3.0 GPA as calculated by GSU

Test Score Minimums:

SAT/PSAT: 530 Reading & Writing, 530 Math

ACT: 20 English or Reading and 21 Math

Accuplacer: 237 Nex-Gen Reading and 4 WritePlacer and 258 Nex-Gen QAS (Math)

Atlanta Campus

Test Score Minimums:

SAT/PSAT: 580 Reading & Writing, 580 Math

ACT: 23 English or Reading and 23 Math

Test Score Minimums:

SAT - 530 Rdg/Wtg, 480 Math, 1050 Combined

PSAT - 480 Rdg/Wtg, 440 Math, 1050 Combined

ACT/PreACT - 20 Rdg, 18 Math, 20 Composite

Accuplacer - 243 Rdg, 266 Math, 4 Writeplacer

**Students taking Accuplacer for consideration of admission for Dual Enrollment will be allowed to retest one time.
Students must meet both subsection requirements and the combined/composite score requirement to be considered for dual enrollment admission.
