# What is AP?

- Advanced Placement courses are college level and taught at the high school.
- Students *MAY* earn college credit for their performance on the end of year AP exams if they score a 3-5.
- These courses are very rigorous and require a greater time commitment than standard college prep courses.
- The courses are taught with higher student performance expectations.

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# AP Human Geography

- Topics covered in AP Human Geography
  - Geographic Principles
  - Population and Migration
  - Culture
    - Language, Religion, Ethnicity, Gender
  - Political Geography
  - Economic Development
    - Processes and Characteristics, including Economic Activities (Agriculture, Industry and Services)
  - Rural Patterns and Processes
  - Urban Patterns and Processes
- These topics are covered thematically rather than regionally.







# How does AP Human Geography fit with the graduation requirements for Social Studies?

- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade – *Electives*, **AP Human Geography** or World Geography/US History in Film
- 10<sup>th</sup> Grade – World History, Honors World History or **AP World History**
- 11<sup>th</sup> Grade – US History or **AP US History**
- 12<sup>th</sup> Grade – Economics (*Semester course*) or **AP Economics** (*Yearlong course*) **AND**
  - Government (*Semester course*) or **AP Government** (*Yearlong course*)

***Bold** indicates HOPE Rigor courses*

World History, US History and Economics/Government credits are required for graduation!
