

**Forsyth County Schools**  
**2022-2023 Re-Districting Proposal**

---

**High Schools:** Nothing proposed for 2022-2023

**Middle Schools:** Nothing Proposed for 2022-2023

**Elementary Schools:** There are two major concerns that we need to address for 2022-2023

1. Overcrowding at several existing elementary schools.
2. Populating New Hope ES, which is scheduled to open in the August of 2022.

**Part A.** Re-district students from Midway, Vickery Creek, Shiloh Point, and Whitlow to populate New Hope Elementary School and to relieve overcrowding in each of them.

\*\*\*\*Please NOTE: 5<sup>th</sup> Graders will be allowed to stay behind, as will their siblings (for 1 year). Therefore, the NEW ENROLLMENT projected numbers are really for the '23-'24 school year once everyone settles into their newly districted schools.\*\*\*\*

Based on projections, New Hope students will feed into the following middle schools:

- 47%** will move on to Vickery Creek Middle School
- 20%** will move on to Piney Grove Middle School
- 33%** will move on to DeSana Middle School

**Part B.** Re-district students from Brandywine to Big Creek Elementary School.

Based on projections, Big Creek students will feed into the following middle schools:

- 45%** will move on to DeSana Middle School
- 31%** will move on to Piney Grove Middle School
- 24%** will move on to South Forsyth Middle School
