

Hello Longhorn Families,

We wanted to share some upcoming dates and information as we step in to registration season.

2020-21 Registration Timeline:

After having conversations with students during the month of January, teachers will be entering course recommendations in the portal by **February 10**.

Students/parents will be able to view these recommendations when the elective registration window opens on Wednesday, **March 4**. Students will need to select electives and alternate electives for next year in the portal between **March 4** and **March 11** at 4:00 pm, when the portal will close. We advise that students/parents take a screenshot of the recommended core courses, as they will not be viewable in the portal after **March 11** at 4:00 pm.

Any parent with questions about entering elective course selections are welcome to attend counselor drop-in dates on **March 5** and **March 9** from 8:30-3:00 pm.

On **March 16**, the waiver window will open to allow students to request any course changes, so that Lambert can begin planning to accommodate course requests and make staffing decisions for the 2020-21 school year. The waiver window for course changes ends on **March 23** at 4:00 pm.

Lastly, on **March 31** the portal will open one last time to view all requested courses. Remember, this is not your schedule, but simply a list of the courses students have requested. Again, we encourage students to take a screenshot of the courses listed in the portal, as the portal will close on **April 2** at 4:00 pm.

To recap:

- **Feb. 3-10** - Teachers enter core course recommendations in the portal (cannot be viewed by students/parents until March 4)
- **March 4-11 @4:00 pm** - Students may view core course recommendations and select elective courses and alternates
- **March 5 and March 9** - Counselor drop in dates to assist parents with questions about entering course selections in the portal.
- **March 16-23 @4:00 pm**- Waiver window for course changes is open
- **March 31-April 2 @4:00 pm** - Portal is open for review of requested courses (NO changes can be made at this time and this is not a schedule)
