### SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

Goal 1: Increase the average lexile score of students failing the 9th Grade Lit. EOC from an average score of 1007 (spring 2018) to 1225 (spring 2019).

Goal 2: Increase the average lexile score of students failing the 9th Grade Lit. EOC from an average score of 925 (spring 2018) to 1000 (spring 2019). Strategies will continue through the 2020 and 2021 school year. Lexile scores will be checked when students take the American Lit. EOC Spring of 2021 with a lexile average target of 1225.
