PMES is named after the National Historic Registered Poole's Mill, which is named for the third owner of the mill, Dr. M.L. Pool. Elements from the wooden lattice truss bridge are incorporated into the school's exterior canopies and lobby with exposed trusses and stone columns resembling bridge support piers.
