SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

Goal 1: The percentage of students across all grade levels who are proficient or higher as measured by IRLA and as documented in School Pace will increase from 76.9% (in May 2021) to 80% by the end of the 2021-22 school year (May 2022).

Goal 2: Implement the PBIS Tier II action plan with a focus on providing the Check-in/Check-out intervention to 3-5% of our student population and meeting at least twice quarterly as a Core Team in the 2021-2022 school year.

Goal 3: By the end of the 2021-2022 school year, 75% of Kindergarten through 5th grade students will demonstrate consistent achievement (>70%) on the Big 10/20 basic numeracy skills assessment.
