SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

Goal 1: By the end of the 2021-2022 school year, we will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or higher from 70.1% to 74% as measured by the 2022 Spring Georgia Milestones ELA Assessment.

Goal 2: In an effort to increase student resilience, all teachers will teach and implement Best Me lessons on a bi-weekly basis during the 2021-2022 school year. Best Me is a Social Emotional Learning program designed by administration and the Leadership Team based on the work of Steven Covey and The Seven Mindsets.
