<b>Social Studies</b> <b><u>3 Units</u></b>	World History, US History, Government (.5), Economics (.5)		
<b>Health/Physical Education</b> <b><u>1 Unit</u></b>	Physical Education (.5) Health (.5) (3 units of JROTC may be used to meet the requirement)		
<b>CTAE and/or World Language and/or Fine Arts</b> <b><u>3 Units</u></b>	<i>Students planning to enter or transfer into a University System of Georgia institution or other post-secondary institution must complete two units of the same World Language.</i>		
<b>Electives</b> <b><u>4 Units</u></b>	State requires 4 additional electives
