

**Forsyth Central High School
Advanced Placement Exam Registration
November 12, 2018-February 3, 2019**

Forsyth Central High School Administration and Advanced Placement teachers feel it is important that students take the AP exam that corresponds with their AP classes. The hard work and dedication students demonstrate throughout the year serve as preparation for these tests, and there are several benefits to taking these exams. One benefit includes earning college credit: if students make an acceptable score (determined by the college of interest), families may save thousands of dollars in tuition, books, and fees.

Forsyth Central High School is excited to offer families the ability to pay their exam fees online at the time of registration through Total Registration (TR).

 - Login and follow the specific instructions.
 - You may pay with a credit card, check or money order by using this site.
 - Students may register from November 12th- February 3th as a part of regular registration
- Each exam will cost \$95.00 and a \$25.00 administration fee, per student, each exam year.

REQUEST REFUNDS through your Total Registration account.

- Refund available until March 1st - \$25 Administrative fee will be withheld.

LATE REGISTRATION

- **February 4th through February 8th.**
- Late registration will incur a **\$25 Late Fee per registration.**
- **NO REFUNDS ON LATE EXAM REGISTRATION**

Please note: Information regarding exam locations will be sent through emails provided by students/parents in the Total Registration platform. **For communication and test organization purposes, it is important that all registration information is entered correctly into TR and the email(s) supplied are checked frequently.**

Failure to arrive on time to an exam, mistake the location, confuse the date, or other scheduling errors on the part of the student will FORFEIT the exam fee and no make-up exam will be offered, so plan accordingly and early for your AP Exams.

Parents and students should also not regard the cost of AP Exams as a deterrent to taking any or all exams. There is financial aid available through College Board and also through the school. If the cost is preventing students from taking an exam, please email or contact Mrs. Kelli Schuyler (kschuyler@forsyth.k12.ga.us), in the room 307 located in room 301 administrative office of East campus. **Please read carefully the letter regarding changes regarding AP Exam funding from the state.**

In order to verify the student's qualification and apply the fee reduction, a copy of the student's free and reduced approval letter must be provided to Kelli Schuyler AP Coordinator at FCHS before Friday, Feb 8, 2019. If you do not have a copy of your approval letter, please contact Joe Sanders at jsanders@forsyth.k12.ga.us to request a copy of your free/reduced lunch approval letter.

If any students wish to take AP exams that are scheduled for the same time and same day, please see contact Mrs. Kelli Schuyler (kschuyler@forsyth.k12.ga.us). The calendar is set by the College Board and there are very specific instructions for exam conflicts.

Dear AP Students and Parents/Guardians:

For the 2018-19 school year, the state of Georgia will pay for AP Exams for two options of public school students.

Option 1. For public school students who individually qualify for the College Board fee reduction, the state of Georgia will **pay for one AP Exam** in any subject (with the exception of AP Seminar and AP Research Exams.)

- Please note that the state will only pay for **one exam for this category of students** and documentation for individual qualification must be available in the event of an audit.
 - Students in this category, who are taking more than one exam, the College Board provides **a reduced cost of \$53.00 per exam** to be paid by the student.
- **Students in this category must supply a copy of their Free and Reduced Lunch approved eligibility form to Mrs. Schuyler in room 307, located in the 301 administrative office on East.** (kschuyler@forsyth.k12.ga.us)

Option 2. For public school students who do not qualify for the College Board fee reduction, the state of Georgia will pay for one AP STEM content exam for each student enrolled in an AP STEM course. All other exams will be paid by the student or school. **Students are still responsible for the \$25 administrative fee- only the exam fee is waived.**

The STEM related courses include the following:

Any student currently receiving free and reduced lunch and are taking an AP course, please submit a copy of your Free and Reduced eligibility approval letter to Kelli Schuyler, by February 8, 2019.
