All 9-12th grade students enrolled in the following courses should plan to come to South Forsyth High School based on the testing schedule below. Report to school by 8:15am and go to your assigned testing location.

- Students who attend specialized instruction classes should attend school that day as normal
- For students who cannot stay at home due to family and / or technological circumstances, online asynchronous learning will be facilitated in the building. Students will not attend classes in their normal classrooms for this.
- Buses will run their normally scheduled AM and PM times. Students can ride the bus to school and then go to their EOC test.
- Lunch will be served at noon each day, or at the end of the EOC exam, if that exam is to end after noon.

With parent / guardian permission, students who report for the EOC's **MAY** leave school upon completion of the test.

- In order for students to leave, families must provide their own transportation. Please pick students up in the front of the school.
- Students who cannot leave will be moved to a central location to complete their online (asynchronous) learning for the remainder of the day.
