Steps to Participate in Dual Enrollment

Learn

- Attend Dual Enrollment Information Night or view the presentation.

Test

- Take the SAT/ACT and/or ACCUPLACER exams.
- Send scores to college.

Apply

- Students should research institutions' admissions requirements on their own.
- Send DHS transcript to college via Parchment.
- Apply.

College Admissions

- Student will be evaluated by the college to determine admissions decision.

HS Counselor Parent/Guardian and Student Meeting

- Email your counselor to set up a meeting time to discuss the program and course selection.
- Counselor will assist with filling out Student Participation Agreement from FCS.

Funding

- Student must log on to www.gafutures.org and complete the online Dual Enrollment Funding Application. Students are required to complete the online Dual Enrollment Funding Application each semester they participate.

College Course Registration

- Student must set up a meeting with an advisor at the college to register for classes. The college advisor will be your point of contact at the college level.

Schedule

- Each semester, students must submit the most up-to-date copy of their college schedule to their counselor. Student's high school schedule cannot be altered and funding cannot be approved without the college schedule.

Communicate

- Students are responsible for staying apprised of pertinent school information through our website and/or other means.
- Students are expected to maintain contact with their counselor during the semester and must acquire approval before dropping classes, withdrawing from classes, changing classes, or discontinuing the dual enrollment program.
