**Example of HOPE Scholarship GPA from high school counselors:**

- The LTC accepted Report is called a “Detailed Student Calculations Report” printed from a counselor from the GSFC website.
- Must be sent from a trusted source to the college (i.e. counselor email, fax, etc.) and must indicated Grade Level 11 or higher.
  - If Grade Level 10 is indicated on the report, of which some 11<sup>th</sup> grade reports “may” reflect, the counselor (trusted source from high school) must indicate on the grade report, by initial, or by official email, the student is indeed in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade.


