

# DUAL ENROLLMENT (Lanier Technical College)

The Dual Enrollment program provides high school students with an opportunity to earn college credit while working on their high school diplomas. Credits earned will be applied to both the high school transcript and the college transcript. All high school students attending public or private high schools in Georgia or home school programs operated in accordance with O.C.G.A. §20-2-690(c) can participate in Dual Enrollment.

## ***Eligibility Requirements***

**To be eligible for the Dual Enrollment program, a student must:**

- Be enrolled in the ninth, tenth, eleventh, or twelfth grade of a private or public high school in Georgia, or a home study program within the State of Georgia operating in accordance with O. C. G. A. §20-2-690(c).
- Be admitted to Lanier Technical College as a dual enrollment student.
- Be enrolled in courses listed in the approved Dual Enrollment Course Directory. The course directory is available at: [www.laniertech.edu/dualenroll](http://www.laniertech.edu/dualenroll).
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by Lanier Technical College.

## ***Application Steps***

**To apply for Dual Enrollment at Lanier Technical College:**

- \*Speak with your high school counselor about the program.
- Submit an online application for Dual Enrollment students available at: [www.laniertech.edu/dualenroll](http://www.laniertech.edu/dualenroll).
- Complete the college admissions test or submit eligible assessment scores on SAT or ACT.
- Receive acceptance letter/email from LTC.
- Complete the Student Participation Agreement form and have it signed by your parents/legal guardian and your high school counselor.
- Attend orientation and registration session with Dual Enrollment college advisor (information on orientation/registration sessions will be included in acceptance letter/email) and register for classes.
- Complete the Dual Enrollment financial aid application on the GAFutures website.
