1. Browse the list of activities being offered for Session 4. SBE **Teacher hosted** activities are held on Mondays, Wednesdays or Fridays, from 2:40 - 3:40 p.m. Each session is a five (5) week period. Session 4 begins on Monday, March 25 and ends on Friday, May 3, 2024. **Register for SBE hosted activities on School Pay.**
2. Once you have completed the School Pay enrollment, please **fill out one copy of the registration form linked above, for each child** you have enrolled in an activity. This form was also linked in the email you received from your child's homeroom teacher announcing session 4 sign-up.
3. **Changes have been made to the after-school activities policies. Please be sure you have read the updated policies which are linked above.**
4. **When the maximum participant enrollment has been reached for an activity, it will no longer appear as an option.** Host teachers have set enrollment levels for the activity. We will not be able to accommodate requests to add additional students to an activity that has met its maximum enrollment. School Pay enrollment is processed in the order completed online.
5. *Please make sure your activity sign-up does not conflict with other after-school commitments for your child(ren) such as chorus, sports, etc. and you have signed up for only one activity per day. Refunds will not be issued after Session 4 has begun on 3/25/24.*
