

Dual Language Immersion (DLI) Interest Form

Forsyth County Schools offers schools the option to implement innovative instructional models. Brandywine, Cumming and Kelly Mill Elementary have opted to implement the Dual Language Immersion Program starting with the 2018-2019 school year. In this instructional model, students spend half of their school day receiving content area instruction in Spanish and the other half-day in English. This model is based on research that indicates that students who receive content area instruction in two languages attain higher levels of language proficiency and academic achievement than their monolingual counterparts.

The goals of the Forsyth County Schools DLI programs are to:

- o Educate bilingual and biliterate students
- o Improve literacy skills;
- Increase academic achievement in all content areas;
- Increase achievement in reading and mathematics significantly;

- Instill cultural competence; prepare students to be sensitive and skilled in working with others across cultures;
- o Prepare students to be collaborators; and
- Prepare students to enter the global workforce
