- Counts to 100 without errors
- Counts by 1's, 5's , and 10's to 100
- Recognizes colors and reads color words
- Identifies and describe shapes 2D & 3D
- Reads and writes first and last name
- Recites address, telephone number, and date of birth
- Recites the days of the week and the months of the year
- Identifies upper/lower case letters and their sounds
- Sorts objects, graphs, and generates patterns
- Expresses ideas through independent writing- using pictures and phonetically spelled words
- Reads Power Words (Sight Words) List - 60 Words
