Two key items that will help you to be successful in your Online C-House experience are to create a time management for yourself and to communicate with your teachers. Here are a few tips and expectations to guide you:

<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Create a daily schedule• Create a designated workspace• Save your work• Communicate to your teachers• Limit screen time	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wake up at your normal time and try to get your work done during regular school hours if possible. When scheduling your day, follow the daily plans that your teachers have created in itslearning. Try to schedule breaks for yourself during the day; you don't have to get all your work for the day completed in one sitting. Stay away from procrastinating to the evening or the next day.• Create a space to do your online work that is not your normal "hangout" place where there may be too many distractions. The kitchen table is often a good place to get work done.• Even though you are probably working in Google docs that will autosave, it is good practice to save to your computer just in case something happens to your WiFi or other systems.• Don't feel like you are bothering your teachers if you have a question. They will be at home working during school hours and they are there for you!• While you are working online, limit your usage of social media or bingeing shows and movies, there are big distractions.
