ANGEL Learning Management System

The learning management system provides a multitude of tools to continue instruction beyond the physical building. Some tools include:

- **ANGEL Course Mail** – Course Mail is a powerful, full-featured communication system. It is a secure and closed system; no one can send an email to a user from outside the ANGEL LMS. However users may set personal settings to allow mail to be forwarded to an internet email account.
- **Discussion Forums** – ANGEL Discussion Forums make it easy to create an online environment that fosters enthusiastic student participation and provide instructors with a host of time saving features.
- **Podcasting** – Nowhere is podcasting – or syndication – as simple as it is in ANGEL. Instructors broadcast audio or video files, links or content items by simply placing them in a course syndication folder.
- **Wikis** – Especially valuable for active peer-to-peer learning and student interaction.
- **Blogs** – Recognized for allowing enhanced comprehension and communication among students as well as for promoting active learning and building deeper understanding.
- **ANGEL LIVE Synchronous Tools** – Virtual Office Hours, Desktop Sharing, Whiteboard and Live Chat.
- **News** – Post announcements and news on your home page, individual course welcome screens or on a departmental homepage. ANGEL's announcement tools provide simple guidance to make posting quick and easy.

The purpose of the Citrix Remote Access Gateway is to provide a secure method by which students and teachers can connect to the district resources while not at school. This provides a way to access documents left on the H drive or to create files on a network drive. This will also be a secure method of providing students access to the FCSS network once school-wide wireless is fully installed in all schools so students will be able to bring their own computing devices to school.
